FARIBAULT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS DRAINAGE AUTHORITY MEETING NOVEMBER 3, 2020

The Faribault County Board of Commissioners met via teleconference in the City of Blue Earth as the Faribault County Drainage Authority pursuant to the recess of the regular session on November 3, 2020. The following members were present: Bill Groskreutz, Tom Loveall, John Roper, Tom Warmka, and Greg Young Commissioners. Auditor/Treasurer/Coordinator Darren Esser, Drainage Manager Merissa Lore, County Attorney Kathryn Karjala, and Acting Clerk to the Board Clara Vereide also attended.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Warmka.

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Young/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve change order #3 for CD21 tile defect repairs bid package #2 for 100 linear feet of 24" tile replacement and 2 cross connections on the main tile totaling \$8,650.00.

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Young/Roper motion carried unanimously to approve change order #2 for CD21 tile defect repairs bid package #4 for 645 linear feet of 36" tile replacement and 2 cross connections on Branch 275 totaling \$32,465.00.

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Young/Groskreutz motion carried unanimously to approve pay application #2 for CD21 tile defect repairs bid package #4 to Brunz Construction for \$64,084.62.

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Roper/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve pay application #5 for CD55 open ditch repair to Brunz Construction for \$12,112.50.

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Groskreutz/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve Resolution 20-DA23-75 setting CD62 bioreactor repair final acceptance hearing for November 17, 2020 at 11:30am at the Faribault County Board Room. Commissioners Groskreutz, Loveall, Roper, Warmka, and Young voted yes.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board of Commissioners approves the following findings and order to hold a final acceptance hearing on the bioreactor repair project on County Ditch 62.

FINDINGS

- 1. The Faribault County Board of Commissioners is the drainage authority for County Ditch 62.
- 2. On June 23 and 24, 2018 a large storm event hit the area causing damage to the County Ditch 62 bioreactor system.
- 3. On September 6, 2018, the President declared Minnesota a major disaster from the June 15 to July 11, 2018 storm events and widespread flooding.
- 4. ISG, Inc. provided the engineering on the project and the project was funded with FEMA and Hazard Mitigation funding.
- 5. The repair project was advertised for bid and awarded to Brunz Construction Company, Inc. on September 3, 2019.
- 6. The final engineer's report and notice that the contract for construction of the bioreactor repair project on County Ditch 62 is complete was received on October 30, 2020.

7. Pursuant to Minnesota Statute §103E.555, public hearing must be held and noticed by mail at least 10 days in advance to owners of property and political subdivisions affected by the drainage project.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings and the entire record of proceedings before the Board, the Board, acting as the drainage authority for County Ditch 62 hereby orders as follows:

- A. A hearing for final acceptance of the bioreactor repair project shall be held on November 17, 2020 at 11:30 a.m. at the Board Room of the Faribault County Courthouse, 415 North Main Street Blue Earth MN 56013.
- B. At least ten days before the hearing, the County Auditor shall mail notice of the time and location of the hearing to owners of property, and political subdivisions likely to be affected by the drainage project.

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Roper/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve Resolution 20-DA24-76 for an order to initiate a redetermination of benefits and damages and appoint viewers on CD74. Commissioners Groskreutz, Loveall, Roper, Warmka, and Young voted yes.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board of Commissioners approves the following findings and order to redetermine benefits for County Ditch 74 and appoint viewers.

Findings

- 1. The Faribault County Board of Commissioners is the drainage authority for County Ditch 74.
- 2. County Ditch 74 was established in 1948. Benefits for County Ditch 74 were determined concurrent with establishment in 1948, prior to the initiation of modern, intensive farming and drainage practices within Faribault County.
- 3. The current benefits roll reflects the benefited properties, benefited areas, and benefit values as determined by viewers based on assumptions regarding the future use and drainage of said properties.
- 4. Since the original establishment of County Ditch 74 and the original determination of benefits and damages, land uses and drainage practices have changed to accelerate and increase the flow of water to the drainage system changing the nature and value of benefits accruing to lands from construction of County Ditch 74.

- 5. Since the original determination of benefits and damages, land values have changed within the benefited area of County Ditch 74.
- 6. The drainage authority held a public meeting on November 3, 2020 to discuss the need for a redetermination of benefits for County Ditch 74.
- 7. The drainage authority finds that the conditions required for the initiation of a redetermination of benefits exist, that the original benefits and damages do not reflect reasonable, present day land values, and the benefited areas have changed.

Order

Based on the foregoing findings and the entire record of proceedings before the Board, the Board, acting as the drainage authority for County Ditch 74, hereby orders as follows:

- A. The Board shall follow the procedures of Minnesota Statute §103E.351 to conduct a redetermination of benefits for County Ditch 74.
- B. That Mark Behrends, Dennis Distad, Bruce Ness, John Thompson, Robert Hansen, and Kendall Langseth are hereby appointed as viewers to redetermination and report the benefits and damages for County Ditch 74.
- C. That with 5 days of the order, the County Auditor-Treasurer shall execute an order designating a time and location for the first meeting of the viewers and mail to the viewers a copy of the Auditor-Treasurer's order along with a certified copy of this order.

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Young/Groskreutz motion carried unanimously to approve sending buffer law penalty invoice on non-compliant parcel 09.010.0501effective immediately.

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Roper/Young motion carried unanimously to approve a letter of non-compliance with a two-week extension on CD55 open ditch repair contract.

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Roper/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve the following inspection reports and make them part of the legal record on CD73, CD26, CD38, CD58, CD69, and CD74.
