#### FARIBAULT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS DRAINAGE AUTHORITY MEETING JANUARY 18, 2022

The Faribault County Board of Commissioners met at the Courthouse in the City of Blue Earth as the Faribault County Drainage Authority at 1:00 p.m. on January 18, 2022. The following members were present: Bruce Anderson, Bill Groskreutz, John Roper, and Greg Young Commissioners. Auditor/Treasurer/Coordinator Darren Esser, Drainage Manager Merissa Lore, and Acting Clerk to the Board Sarah Van Moer also attended. Faribault County employees J. Blair, G. Paschke, L. Scholten, and K. Anderson attended virtually. Commissioner Tom Loveall was absent.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Young.

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Groskreutz/Roper motion carried unanimously to approve the agenda of January 18, 2022.

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No members of the public appeared during public comment.

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Anderson/Roper motion carried unanimously to approve payment of drainage voucher bills totaling \$6,689.02.

Roper/Groskreutz motion carried unanimously to table the CD45 petition to remove property pending legal review.

Roper/Groskreutz motion carried unanimously to approve two estimates from Krueger Excavating for tree removal: CD8 for \$45,500.00 and CD64 for \$32,000.00; and table the remaining estimates until Commissioner Loveall is present as they are in his district.

- C. That within 5 days of this Order, the County Auditor-Treasurer shall execute an Order designating a time and location for the first meeting of the viewers and mail to the viewers a copy of the Auditor-Treasurer Order along with a certified copy of this Order.

Based on the foregoing Findings and the entire record of proceedings before the Board, the Board, acting as the drainage authority for County Ditch #74, hereby orders as follows:

- A. A hearing on the repair report shall be held on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. at the Faribault County Courthouse Board Room, 415 North Main Street Blue Earth,MN 56013.
- B. At least ten days before the hearing, the Faribault County Auditor shall mail notice of the time and location of the hearing to petitioners, owners of property, and political subdivisions likely to be affected by the proposed drainage project in the repair report.

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Staff reports were presented.

The Faribault County Drainage Authority was adjourned for January 2022.
