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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Faribault County Ditch No. 24 (CD 24) Repair project began with a 2014 petition to restore portions of the grassed waterway back to the original legal waterway grade as it was constructed in 1959 and repair the 15-inch tile in the upper portion of the CD 24 watershed. The Final Repair Report was approved in June of 2016. Construction Documents were completed in July 2016 and the project was advertised and bid in August 2016. A total of five bids were received and the project was awarded to the low bidder, Brunz Construction out of Madison Lake, MN.

Construction began in December of 2016 with Brunz making steady progress through 2017. Then construction was delayed due to disputes on portions of the project, an appeal by a landowner and other landowner concerns. In 2022 the system was televised per specifications and multiple repairs were needed. These repairs were completed in 2023.

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

The cost estimate for construction, including contingency, from the Final Repair Report was \$221,313.90. The original contract price was \$211,671.00. There were seven approved change orders approved during the course of the project including \$43,800.45 in additions and \$32,112.00 in deductions resulting in a total cost increase to the project of \$11,688.45. Additional scope included bid items for side intakes, single wall tile, slough repair and shifting the riprap spillway. However, there were also several base bid and change order items that came in under estimate. The final contract price is \$191,543.79..

FINAL PAY REQUEST

To date, the contractor has been paid \$147,160.50 with an unpaid balance of \$39,831.93 left on retainage and a few remaining items to be paid. We recommend payment and final acceptance of the Faribault County Ditch No. 24 Repair project. The Final Pay Request can be found in Appendix B of this report.

AS BUILTS

ISG has completed the As Built plans that will serve as the corrected record of the project. The complete as built is located in Appendix E of this report.

DAMAGES

ISG has captured all of the damages, both temporary and permanent, that had occurred due to the project. It is the Engineer's recommendation that the damages to the properties involved be paid out to the landowners at the rate the board adopted during the final hearing. The complete list of damages per property is located in Appendix D of this report.

CONCLUSION

It is the Engineer's opinion that the Contractor, Brunz Construction, has satisfactorily completed the contract in accordance with plans and specifications. Therefore, the Engineer recommends final payment to the contractor, payment of the constructed damages and abandonment of the existing tile system.

- 13.) ALL STEEL PIPES THAT ARE BORED MUST BE CATHODICALLY PROTECTED.
- 14.) ALL FIELD & ROAD OPEN DITCH CULVERT CROSSINGS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITH CLASS III RCP OR TRIPLE WALL HDPE UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 15.) ALL DEWATERING FOR THE PROJECT IS INCIDENTAL.
- 16.) IN AREAS WHERE CROSS CONNECT IS CALLED OUT, EACH CONNECTION INCLUDES 30 LF OF SPECIFIED TILE, CONNECTION TO THE PROPOSED MAINLINE, AND CONNECTION TO THE EXISTING MAINLINE AND/OR BRANCH.
