There will be a redetermination of benefits hearing on Faribault County Ditch No. 18 (CD18) held on Thursday, January 28th, 2021 at 9:30 am at the Golden Bubble (11575 State Highway 22 Wells, Minnesota 56097). A redetermination of benefits was ordered on May 5th, 2020, due to the benefits not reflecting reasonable present-day land values and change in the benefited area. This meeting will cover the benefit values. See enclosed public notice for more information on the proceeding.


