RE: Repair hearing for proposed repairs to the open ditch of County Ditch #24 (east of 338th Ave.)

Dear Landowner:

There will be a repair hearing on Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 9:30 am at the Riverside Town and Country Club (36259 150<sup>th</sup> St. Blue Earth, MN 56013) on Faribault County Ditch #24 (CD24). A repair petition was filed on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019, to address erosion and sloughing on the open ditch east of 338<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Winnebago City Township Section 9. The Engineer has submitted a repair report with repairs options for the open ditch portion of CD24. 
