RE: Informational Meeting on Feasibility Study on CD46

Dear Landowner:

There will be an informational meeting held on **Monday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 11:00 am at the Golden Bubble** (11575 State Highway 22 Wells, Minnesota 56097) on the feasibility study on Faribault County Ditch #46 (CD46) Emerald Township. There have been several tile holes on the CD46 tile system since 2013 with an increase of issues in 2019 and 2020. An informational meeting was held on August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to review televising results and the condition of the system. The Drainage Authority ordered a Feasibility Study on CD46 on October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. ISG, Inc., an engineering firm based out of Mankato, was hired to complete the Feasibility Study to provide more information about the system's capacity, repair options, and improvement options.

The Engineer filed the Feasibility Study Report on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Landowners are encouraged to attend the meeting on December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

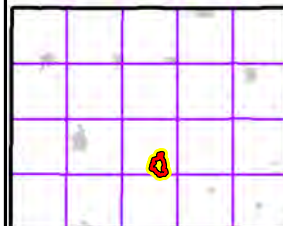
