There will be a final acceptance hearing on Faribault County Ditch No. 55 (CD55) Open Ditch Repair on Friday, January 22nd, 2021 at 9:00 am at the Golden Bubble (11575 State Highway 22 Wells, Minnesota 56097). A repair petition was filed on June 5th, 2018. The Faribault County Board of Commissioners, acting as the drainage authority for CD55, ordered repairs to CD55 open ditch on January 21st, 2020. The repairs were completed by Brunz Construction Company during the 2020 growing season. The Engineer has certified the repair is complete. - 3. By Zoom (internet meeting)




