RE: Hearing to Transfer a portion of County Ditch #87 to the City of Wells

Dear Landowner:

There will be a hearing held to transfer a portion of Faribault County Ditch #87 (CD87) to the City of Wells as the water management authority on Monday, March 28th, 2022, at 4:00 pm at the Wells Community Center (189 2nd Street Southeast Wells, MN 56097). A petition to transfer a portion of CD87 to the City of Wells as the water management authority was filed with the Faribault County Drainage Authority on May 24th, 2018. This meeting will cover the Engineer's Report and the City of Wells request to transfer a portion of CD87 within city limits. This process transfers the authority to maintain the CD87 tile line that serves as the City of Wells storm sewer within city limits and the costs associated with the maintenance of this tile to the City of Wells from the drainage authority. 
