Location: Elmore Township Sections 9-11, 14-16, 21-23, 27

Dear Landowner:

There will be a repair hearing on **Friday**, **December 18th**, **2020 at 1:00 pm** on Faribault County Ditch No. 92 (CD92). A repair petition was filed on December 5th, 2017. The repair involves replacing the upstream portion of the open ditch with 810 feet of 24" tile in Elmore Township Section 22. The Engineer filed the Repair Report on November 30th, 2020. The Repair Report can be viewed at the Faribault County Auditor's Office or online at https://www.co.faribault.mn.us/drainage/pages/notices-reports. Landowners are encouraged to attend the hearing on December 18th, 2020. **See enclosed public notice for more information on the proceeding.**

Due to the pandemic with COVID-19, landowners can join these meeting/hearings 1 of the following 3 ways.


- 1. In person at the Golden Bubble (11575 State Highway 22 Wells, Minnesota 56097) *Map on Back




