RE: Informational Meeting on Repairs to Hueper Branch

Dear Landowner:

There will be an informational meeting held on Friday, March 26th, 2021 at 11:00 am at the Golden Bubble (11575 State Highway 22 Wells, Minnesota 56097) on the proposed repairs to Faribault and Freeborn Joint County Ditch #301 (JCD301FF) Hueper Branch in Clark Township. Televising of the tile was completed for the re-establishment of records process finalized on December 18th, 2020. Televising footage was reviewed and Drainage Staff have compiled repair options for the tile line.

Faribault County Drainage Staff completed a Staff Repair Report for the system. The Staff Repair Report can be viewed at the Faribault County Auditor's Office or online at https://www.co.faribault.mn.us/drainage/pages/notices-reports. Landowners are encouraged to attend the meeting on March 26th, 2021 to provide input on the scope and necessity of the repair.
