Pilot cars and/or flagmen are required front and rear for directing traffic if load width crosses centerline or is 16 feet wide or wider. Pilot cars shall be equipped with flashing amber lights on the top of the vehicle.

Movement within incorporated or congested areas shall be coordinated with local law enforcement.
Arrangements shall be made by the permittee with all utility companies for overhead wires or cables.
No movement shall be made when roads are soft, wet, or slippery or if visibility is poor.
There shall be no movement on Holidays or Holiday weekends.
Movement shall be during daylight hours only unless specifically stated on the face of this permit.
Permission for movement over roads other than County Highways must be obtained from authorities under whose jurisdiction such roads come under.
