BACKGROUND:

Street name signs are essential to E911 services.

Townships are responsible for traffic signs on their town roads. Townships do not have their own forces and equipment to install signs.

POLICY STATEMENT:

Faribault County will furnish and install street name signs on all county highways and township roads at no cost to the townships.

Faribault County will furnish and/or install traffic signs as requested for county townships and/or cities. The township will be billed for time, equipment and materials for each sign installed or just materials for signs picked up at the Blue Earth garage.

Township Responsibility:

Provide a map clearly marking the signs to be repaired or replaced.

Pay for signs and services rendered.

County Responsibility:

Call Gopher One for utility locates. This requires a separate site visit from the actual work

Order signs and schedule work. County signs have priority over township work.

Provide bill to Township.
