*Faribault County Residents Can Now Receive Real Time Public Safety Messages Through Nixle*

**Faribault County, MN-** The Faribault County Sheriff's Office has partnered with Nixle to implement its Community Notification System to alert residents in real-time for localized emergency situations and relevant community advisories.

As a resident, there are several simple ways to register:

1. Text your ZIPCODE to 888777 from your mobile phone
2. Go to [www.frcsd.org](http://www.frcsd.org) and sign up via the Nixle Widget

Once registered, residents will receive a confirmation text to their mobile device. Residents may also customize their alert settings by going to [www.nixle.com](http://www.nixle.com) and creating a User Profile.
