Social Security Numbers & Homesteads

Overview

State law (MS 273.124, subd. 13 par.c) requires that every property owner applying for homestead classification must provide the county assessor with a social security number of each occupant who is listed as owner of the property on the deed of record, including each owner's spouse who occupies the property.

Each owner and their spouse who occupies the property must sign the application. In the case of a relative homestead, both the owner and the qualifying relative must provide a social security number and sign the application.

Confidential Information

Social Security numbers provided to this office are confidential information and will not be disclosed to the public. Under State law (MS 273.124, subd. 13 par.g,h) they may be given by the county assessor to the Minnesota Department of Revenue to determine whether you have applied for the homestead classification for other properties.
